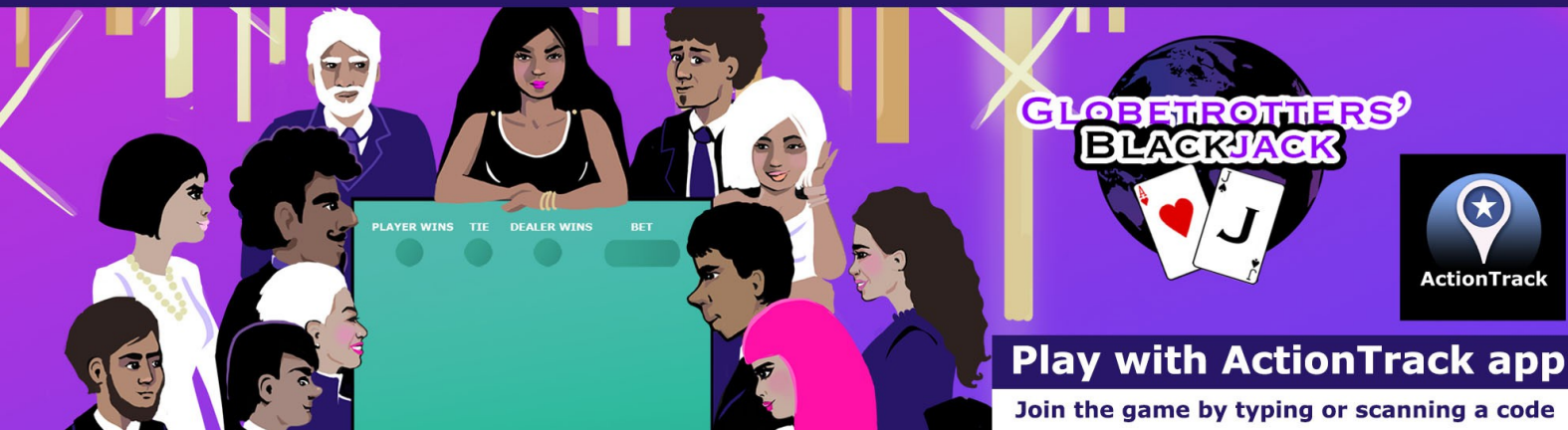


Globetrotters' Blackjack



Globetrotters' Blackjack is a tactical game that mixes risk taking, use of knowledge and optional outdoor walks. The game has 3 levels that bring bonuses and new opportunities for bigger points. The highest scoring player or team wins.

How to use the app

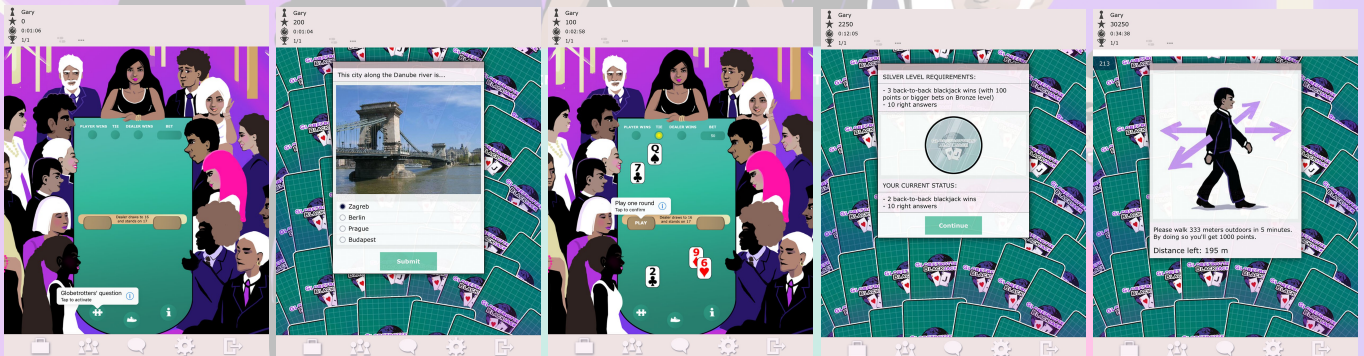
Please zoom the game view to see the whole table

Activate globetrotter questions to get points to blackjack table

Play blackjack against the dealer and set the bets freely

Advance to Bronze, Silver and Gold levels of the game

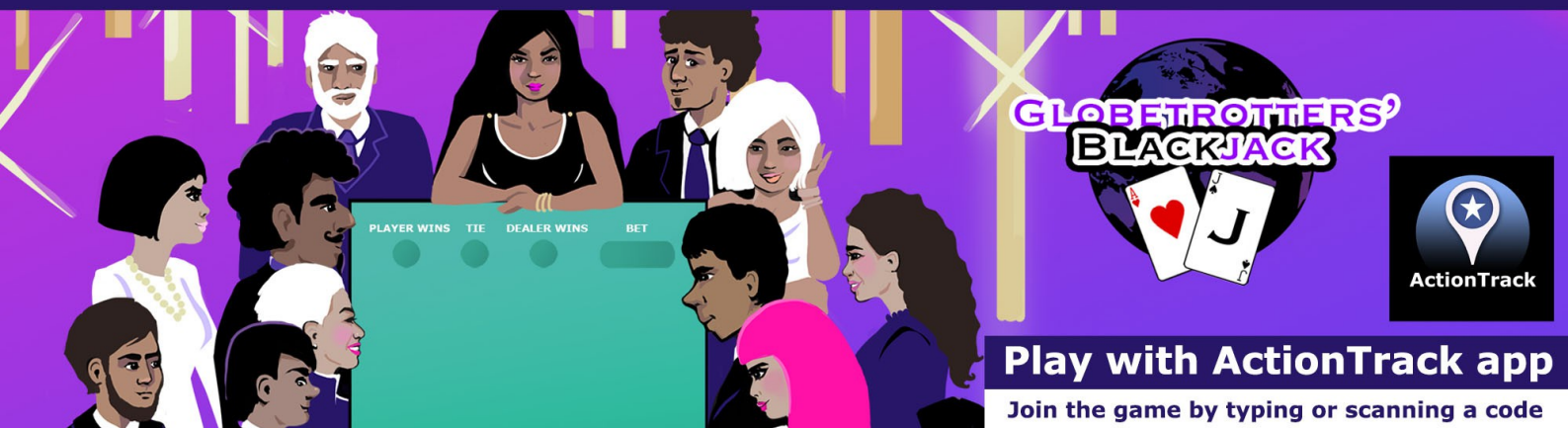
Optional outdoor walks can help you to advance



How to play the game

1. The game features a blackjack table, globetrotter questions and outdoor walk challenges. You can get points from all of these. Notice that you can maximize your score by planning in which order and which quantity each time to experience all of these.
2. You can play up to 50 rounds of blackjack by tapping the "Play" button.
3. You can activate up to 50 globetrotter questions by tapping the "Puzzle" button.
4. You can activate up to five outdoor walk challenges by tapping the "Footprint" button. You need to walk a distance of 333 meters within 5 minutes to get 1000 points.
5. The game features Bronze, Silver and Gold levels. You need to get two back-to-back wins in blackjack and give 5 right answers to get to the Bronze level. You need to get three back-to-back wins on Bronze level in blackjack (with bets of 100 points or more) and give 10 right answers to get to the Silver level. You need to get three back-to-back wins on Silver level in blackjack (with bets of 500 points or more) OR do a walk challenge to get to the Gold level.
6. Getting to the Bronze level gives 500 points, opens a 500-point bet, and gives a 100 points bonus for each right answer that is given on the Bronze level.
7. Getting to the Silver level gives 1000 points, opens a 1000-point bet, and gives a 200 points bonus for each right answer that is given on the Silver level.
8. Getting to the Gold level gives 5000 points, opens a 5000-point bet, and gives a 500 points bonus for each right answer that is given on the Gold level.
9. The highest scoring player or team wins.

Globetrotters' Blackjack table rules

- ✓ The card deck is shuffled every time before a new round.
- ✓ In the beginning of the round you must place your bet, either 20, 50, 100, 500, 1000 or 5000 points. Your bet cannot exceed the amount of points you have. Bets up to 100 points are available at the beginning of the game. The higher bets become available when you advance in the game to Bronze, Silver and Gold levels.
- ✓ Next the dealer deals one card to herself and one card to you.
- ✓ Next you need to decide whether to draw a new card, or to fold. You can draw as many cards as you want as long as the sum of your cards does not exceed 21. Your aim is to get as close to 21 as possible, but not to get over 21.
- ✓ Picture cards (=jack, queen and king) are worth 10 each.
- ✓ An ace is worth 1 or 11. The ace values are automatically set so that they maximize the value of the hand, and keep the sum as 21 or below if possible.
- ✓ If you get 21 with two cards you have the "Blackjack", and you win directly 2,5 x bet.
- ✓ When you fold, the dealer starts dealing cards to herself. The dealer must draw to 16, and fold on 17 (or more).
- ✓ If your hand is closer to 21 than the dealer's hand, you win 2 x bet.
- ✓ If the hands are equal (17, 18, 19, 20 or 21), the dealer wins if she has the "Blackjack". Otherwise the outcome is called a "Tie", and you get your bet back.
- ✓ If the dealer's hand is closer to 21, the dealer wins, and you lose your bet.
